Sunday 15th April

During our recent visit to the Gambia we went to an area I hadn't been to before. Our hotel was right next to a river, our rooms were very basic and it was all a bit scary. I was completely out of my comfort zone and very concerned. However, there were some things that kept me feeling safe; my DEET insect repellent spray and my mosquito net. I prayed to God and thanked Him for these two simple items that I was lucky to have.

It got me thinking. If I was this worried, how must Gambians feel every day? Malaria is a life-threatening mosquito-borne blood disease caused by a Plasmodium parasite. It is endemic across the Gambia. The use of long-lasting insecticide-treated bed nets provides protection from the mosquitos and give parents the opportunity and ability to keep themselves and their children safe.

A container is going out to Gambia on the 28th April. With your support, I would like to send out 100 life-saving mosquito nets. They cost £7:00 each. Please help me reach my target by buying some cakes from the Messy Church team after the service or by making a small donation; any amount, no matter how small, will make a difference.
