The whole sanctuary area is covered by an **Induction loop.**

Cloakrooms There are toilets (incl. disabled) at the front of the church and at the back of the halls.

Provision for children: There is a crèche at the back of the church for children under 3 should you need it. You are welcome to stay and listen to the service there. Or there is a play area within the worship area where your child can find activities relevant to today's worship.
