Small Steps Big Change

At our House Group tonight we were exploring what we would study next.

Denzel posed the question as to what question we would like to answer in our studying of the Bible. We felt that we wanted to learn more about sharing our faith guided by our Bible reading. We discussed where in the community we had the opportunity to share our faith and where we were already working -such as the Lighthouse – and where there was the greatest need- such as the York Road homeless shelter.

'Everyday Church – mission by being good neighbours' by Tim Chester and Steve Timmis talks about today's Christians being like missionaries. The culture has moved on. We cannot assume people feel any need or obligation to attend church. So, we must go out and meet them in their places in the community. This led us to discussing how we can work more in the community as a church and whether we needed to wait and develop a strategy or whether we could start with something small. We were reminded of the country and western song 'Little by Little'. If everyone did one small act of kindness what a difference it would make in the World. Small steps make a Big change. We left vowing to each try and make one small difference. What small step could you make in sharing your faith?
