A message from the leadership team

A few weeks ago I worshipped with my son in the Methodist Church in Acomb, York, where they were holding their Circuit celebration. Part of the celebration was a presentation about the youth manifesto from 3Generate which has also been presented to the Methodist Conference. I was struck by how much the thoughts of the young people in their manifesto chimed with our proposed work on the Foundry in Woking.

Jasmine Yeboah, the Youth President, has been encouraging young people to step outside of their comfort zone to do something courageous for Christ. Jasmine speaks of the priority for the Church to listen to the voices of children and young people. The young people have developed a manifesto which includes:

- taking action on homelessness,
- building relationships within communities,
- supporting the lonely,
- caring for the environment,
- creating safe spaces for people to listen to each other and
- being creative in worship.
