Last week I was visiting family, and we were lucky enough to have the weekend in Staithes, near Whitby. We came across the Primitive Methodist Church – which had had one building, and then obviously grown, and built a bigger building next door. We realised that it was now the local museum. It held a random collection of items, as it had been the private collection of one person until he died, and then the townspeople bought the ex-Methodist Church and his collection. He had been a fan of Capt. James Cook, so a lot of the collection related to various expeditions of Cook, local artists, and local events. On the photos, people had written the names of those they knew. To remember them and their stories.

One of my photos is of the old collection bowl which would have been passed along the pews, and they also had photos of the membership cards!

It was interesting and a bit sad to be in a museum that had once been the local Methodist Church, but the volunteers there welcomed us and informed us and cared that we knew their stories.

Back to real life, and I have been doing a Pastoral Care Course.

We have looked at various issues - welcoming, hospitality, praying and listening, and how important each one of us is.

Some quotes from the materials are below:

"The call to care for others is part of the call of Christian discipleship to which we are all invited to respond. To support one another and to pastor to another, is to find a way of living out that pastoral calling with compassion in its widest sense."

"Jesus' teaching offers a way of seeing things differently and the opportunity for us to consider again how we might each respond pastorally to the people and situations around us."

I thank God for the chance to see family, to be by the sea, to engage with new people, to have a chance to learn with new people, and for the caring community at Trinity. It matters that someone knows you.



Under 6s must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver.


